To all permitted users of the public rights-of-way:

The holiday season is quickly approaching; in support of this season with its accompanied events and activities, Portland's Bureau of Transportation implements a moratorium on construction use of the public right-of-way. Due to increased activity in the city's major retail districts during the holiday season, beginning November 18, 2011 and continuing through January 1, 2012, Portland's Bureau of Transportation increases focus on keeping traffic moving freely and on-street parking available.

The moratorium prevents the closing of parking spaces, sidewalks, travel lanes and streets in the core areas as follows:

- **Downtown** within the boundary formed by the Willamette River, SW Market Street, SW 13th Avenue and West Burnside Street.
- **Portland's Old Town Chinatown Business District and Pearl District** within the boundary formed by the Willamette River, NW Pettygrove Street, NW 14th Avenue and West Burnside Street.
- **The Lloyd District** within the boundary formed by NE 16th Avenue, NE Broadway, NE Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. and NE Lloyd Blvd.

The moratorium also prevents the closing of travel lanes and street closures city-wide per the following:

- **Major streets throughout the City** as shown on the Moratorium Map available on line at www.portlandonline.com/transportation or at 1900 SW 4th Avenue, first floor permit center.

Some limited work will continue for Portland Streetcar Loop.

Exemptions:

Portland's Bureau of Transportation and its Holiday Construction Moratorium Committee consider requests for exemptions to the moratorium based on verifiable need for work in the public right-of-way. An exemption form is available on line at www.portlandonline.com/transportation. The completed form shall be submitted in writing as per the information below:
